## Fish Scales

A repeating pattern of small nested chevrons reminiscent of scales.

## Three-Color Fish Scales

This thick weave features three different colors of nested chevrons.

Threading in both directions follows an ABACAD pattern starting from the bottom-right corner. Weaving switches between rows of $\mathrm{O} 2 / \mathrm{U} 1$ and rows of O3/U3, shifting over one on each row.
