





### **Small Square Spiral Bands**






### Square Double Spiral







### **Greek Key**







### Floating Diamond

For better symmetry, omit loop 18 in each direction.







### **Floating Circle**

Worked in mostly tabby (over/under) weaving, mirrored pairs of over-two floats change the line directions to create the optical illusion of a circle.








### Branch






Parallel Branches (Arms of 4)(18)









Parallel Branches (Arms of 2)(18)

A diagonal stripe of alternating floats generates a series of diverging lines. The puffy floats form a rib that stands out from the flatter sections of the fabric.








### **Crazy Eights**

A puffy modified-twill fabric. When taken off the loom, the enclosed spots shrink as the figure-eight and contrasting square motifs pull up around them.








First charted in December 2021; revised June 2022.







### Three-Color Fish Scales

This thick weave features three different colors of nested chevrons.

Threading in both directions follows an ABACAD pattern starting from the bottom-right corner. Weaving switches between rows of O2/U1 and rows of O3/U3, shifting over one on each row.









### Fifties Banded Flair

The neat rows of interlocking Greek keys and parallel rectangles soften when removed from the loom, leaving a pattern of organic shapes distributed between even straight lines.

An original design charted in April 2022.

For better symmetry, omit loop 18 in each direction.







### Pierced Lattice

This pattern dramatically alters when removed from the loom, with the smallest single-pick spots on each side disappearing, and the H shapes on the front merging into long vertical bars.






### **Tri-Color Pierced Lattice**
